Based in Apopka at Hope CommUnity Center, the Notre Dame Mission Volunteers-AmeriCorps members tutor & mentor youth in public schools, staff after-school and arts programs and youth groups, teach adults English, GED and Citizenship education, work with survivors of domestic violence, help with parenting and family empowerment education and support groups, and do many other things.

Join a team of dedicated people working together to change the world. Service term begins early September 2018; ends late July 2019. Requires about 40 hours/week for 11 months (must complete at least 1,700 hours in 11 months). AmeriCorps members:

- Earn \$13,732 (about \$900/month)
- Receive health insurance

- Get a child care benefit if qualified
- Earn Education Award about \$5,920

Requirements: Good heart & work ethic; Green Card or US citizenship; enough English proficiency to work with people learning English; academic skills; love of people; bilingual welcomed though not required
